Mark has also previously supported the City of Chicago in developing innovative curb management strategies and co-authored a tactical outdoor design guide for the Illinois Restaurant Association. A graduate of the University of Wisconsin and the Harvard University Graduate School of Design, Mark served as co-Editor-in-Chief of the American Planning Association's 2020 State of Transportation Planning Report.
